RESOLUTION #95-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF EXCESS SEAWALL PIPE TO THE CIVIL AIR PATROL FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Civil Air Patrol is a civilian, volunteer, non-combatant auxiliary of the Air Force and a private, non-profit public service entity; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Air Patrol provides a life-saving service of Search and Rescue and civil disaster flights in the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Air Patrol needs the use of a float plane to carry out its missions to the best of their ability; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Air Patrol must currently load and off-load its plane at Hanger Lake with no dock or walkway, severely hampering its efforts; and

WHEREAS, building a permanent dock/walkway would enable the Civil Air Patrol to more fully utilize the float plane and provide greater service to the Y-K Delta; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has excess seawall pipe that would not be used for City purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Air Patrol is requesting eight pieces of this excess pipe to build the dock/walkway; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Air Patrol is willing to purchase the pipe for one dollar per pipe; and

WHEREAS, the Port Commission has reviewed and supports the Civil Air Patrol's request.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Bethel City Council that the Council approves the disposal of eight pieces of seawall pipe to the Civil Air Patrol at the purchase price of one dollar per pipe for the purposes of constructing a dock/walkway for its float plane.
