

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Guinn called the Special Meeting of the Bethel City Council to order at 7.40 pm.

NEW BUSINESS: Public Hearing FY '84 CITY BUDGET

Item A: FY '84 Budget

Mayor Guinn opened the public hearing at 7.45 pm.

City Manager Hoffman reviewed for Council the Administration's proposed budget. Finance Chairperson Carpenter reviewed for Council the Finance Committee recommendations. The Administration accepted Finance Committee recommendations with the following changes:

- 5% COLA for all employees
- budget, including personnel costs, adopted for the entire FY
- position classification and City reorganization plan to be presented to Council by December 1

The following items were discussed during the public hearing on the budget:

- COLA (who should receive, how much, how determined);
- need for a budget ordinance outlining the budget process to be followed;
- utilization of budget savings resulting from recommended budget cuts to reinstitute Community Services Patrol.

Mayor Guinn closed the public hearing at 9.39 pm.

motion M/M by Pavil, 2nd by Hoffman to adopt Ordinance 146, a City budget for FY '84 with the Finance Committee recommended cuts (see attached) and a COLA of 5% for all employees. Poll vote taken, motion passed unanimously.

motion M/M by Pavil, 2nd by Binkley directing the City Administration to present to Council a City vehicle use policy. Voice vote, motion passed.

motion M/M by Hoffman, 2nd by Anvil directing Administration to present to Council an employee reclassification/Administrative reorganization plan by December 1, 1983. Voice vote, motion passed.

ADJOURNMENT M/M by Pavil to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 9.46 pm.
