ORDINANCE #04-05

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4.04.080 OF THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING WHEN REQUESTS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS NEED TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE CITY COUNCIL

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Bethel Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. Amendment. Section 4.04.080 of the Bethel Municipal Code entitled "Budget – Control" is amended to read as follows (new language is underlined and old language is stricken out):

4.04.080 Budget-Control.

Budgetary control is exercised at the departmental level. The city's manager may approve intra-departmental transfers of appropriated funds not directed to personnel services and only to the extent such transfers do not exceed five thousand dollars. Any supplemental appropriations that amend the total budgeted expenditures of any department and all inter-departmental transfers of appropriated funds shall be by ordinance. The request for any supplemental appropriation shall be submitted to the council as soon as the city manager becomes aware that the total expenditure for any line item has exceeded the budgeted expenditure for that line item by five thousand dollars.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage by the City Council.
