

ORDINANCE NO. 75

An Ordinance Prohibiting the Public Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages and Providing Punishment Therefore.


Section A. It shall be unlawful for any person to consume an alcoholic beverage on or along any public street, sidewalk, alley, or walkway; in any public park, mode of public transportation, cemetery, dump site, harbor, parking lot, airport, or school yard; in any public building, or in any building held open for use by the public, or any building owned by the City of Bethel held open for use by the public.

Section B. The City Manager is authorized to designate public areas and places, in addition to those specified in Section A. above, in which the consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited, and to cause signs to be posted in such areas or places advising members of the public of the prohibition.

Section C. A person who is guilty of drinking in public is punishable by a fine of not more than \$100.00. In no event shall any fine less than \$25.00 be imposed and such fine shall not be suspended, nor may the punishment provided in this Section be reduced under A.S. 11.05.150.
