

R E S O L U T I O N 55

PROPOSAL FOR TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT
OF LEGAL SERVICES ASSISTANTS

WHEREAS, there is a great need to encourage, the entry into the legal profession of rural Alaska native people; and

WHEREAS, Alaska Legal Services Corporation proposes a program for training and employment of Legal Services Assistants who are rural Alaska native people and who will work toward becoming lawyers; and

WHEREAS, it is expected that the State of Alaska will be interested in participating in this project and should be willing to finance approximately \$60,000 per year of the cost of such program,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL that Governor Keith H. Miller is urged to include in his 1970 budget request to the legislature the sum of \$60,000 for the Legal Services Assistants program of Alaska Legal Services; and further, be it

RESOLVED that the 1970 Alaska Legislature is urged to approve State participation in this program and appropriate \$60,000 for Fiscal Year 1970 as the State's share in this program.
