AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO 15, BY REPEALING AND RE-ENACTING SECTIONS 1, 2 and 3, PROVIDING A PENALTY AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS

SECTION 1. UNLAWFUL DEPOSIT OF WASTE PROHIBITED. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to deposit, dump or in any manner dispose of human waste, offal or excrement within the City of Bethel except as herein specified:

- (a) By subscription to the "City Sanitation Service" at the prices and frequencies of pickup as prescribed by the City Council of the City of Bethel. Containers for said pickup service shall be of not more than five (5) gallon capacity and shall be equipped with a bail sufficiently strong to be safely handled when full.
- (b) By use of suitable septic tanks or sewage plants. Any new construction to conform to and be installed in accordance with City and State Laws.
- (c) By use of out door toilets of usual construction which meets with all State Laws rules and regulations except that in no event will out door toilets be used without sufficient chemical treatment daily to avoid all odor and kill all bacteria.

SECTION 2. PENALTY. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or ten days in jail or both.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage by the City Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska
