

- ORDINANCE #48

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #41 BY REPEALING AND ENACTING SECTIONS II B, II C, III C, III D, IV B/2, V A, AND ADDING SECTION VIII AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA;

SECTION I, ENACTING.

Sections II, III, V, of Ordinance #41 are hereby enacted by law as follows:

Sec. II B. A registration is valid for one year commencing Oct. 1st of each year, and the annual registration fee is one dollar (\$1.00).

Sec. II C. Upon registration of the snowmobile, the registrant shall be issued a registration certificate and a numbered decal containing the registration number of the vehicle. Numbered registration decals shall be displayed on the right of the cowling of a snowmobile.

Sec. III D. Every snowmobile shall at all times be equipped with a muffler in good working order and in constant operation to prevent excessive noise. The noise level shall be 86 decibels or less when measured at 50 feet.

Sec. IV B/2. When towing a sled, no snowmobile shall travel at a speed greater than eight miles per hour while on the streets of Bethel (as fast as a man can run).

Sec. V A. No snowmobile shall be operated by a person under the age of 14 years on the public streets and all operators need a special operators permit to drive on City streets.

SECTION II, REPEALER.

Section III C, of Ordinance #41, is hereby repealed.

SECTION III, ADDITION.

Section VIII. Use of Snowmachine Paths.

Snowmachine paths shall be designated and marked within the City of Bethel and snowmachines shall be operated on them. The where-abouts of these paths will be discribed over KYUK and in the Kuskokwim Kronicle.

SECTION IV.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and in effect on April 27, 1972.
