SUPPORT FOR THE COMMUNITY SERVICE PATROL PROGRAM AND THE CITY'S APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS), Division of Health, is requested a non-competitive proposal from the City of Bethel to provide Community Service Patrol services for the state fiscal year 2009;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel, Police Department, recognized the benefits of the program to residents and visitor of the Bethel community, and assembled a start-up and operating budget for the program;

WHEREAS, the City completed and submitted a grant application to DHSS that requested \$273,203 to begin and operate the program from January 1, 2009 to June 30, 2009;

WHEREAS, the former City's Korean Church building is designated in the grant application as the intended office setting for the three full-time Community Service Patrol staff members who will be hired to run the program;


WHEREAS, grant program funds requested include \$5,000 to renovate part of the first floor of the former Korean Church building;

WHEREAS, the City intends to contribute \$28,109 in-kind by providing training, janitorial services, and staff oversight, but no cash match;


