

RESOLUTION 441

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA REQUESTING FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES, FOR THE BETHEL TRANSIT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, SECTION 18 OF THE URBAN MASS TRANSPORTATION ACT OF 1964, AS AMENDED, PROVIDES FOR CAPITAL AND OPERATING GRANTS TO PUBLIC TRANSPORT PROVIDERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSISTING THEM IN PROVIDING PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICES; AND

WHEREAS, THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF ALASKA, IN ACCORDANCE WITH A REQUEST BY THE URBAN MASS TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION (HEREINAFTER CALLED UMTA) HAS DESIGNATED THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES, TO EVALUATE AND SELECT PROJECTS PROPOSED BY THE PUBLIC TRANSIT PROVIDERS AND TO COORDINATE THE GRANT APPLICATIONS; AND


WHEREAS, THE AUTHORITY TO RECEIVE AND EXPEND FEDERAL FUNDS HAS BEEN APPROPRIATED BY THE ALASKA LEGISLATURE; AND


WHEREAS, THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES, HAS ALLOCATED \$63,120.00 FOR THE CITY OF BETHEL TRANSIT SYSTEM,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA THAT THE CITY COUNCIL DIRECTS THE CITY ADMINISTRATION TO REQUEST \$63,120.00 FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES, FOR THE BETHEL TRANSIT SYSTEM.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA THAT THE CITY ADMINISTRATION IS DIRECTED TO ACCEPT AND TO IMPLEMENT THE GRANT FUNDS FOR THE BETHEL TRANSIT SYSTEM.
