RESOLUTION #96-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, APPROVING A FUEL THROUGH-PUT FEE INCREASE PER SECTION 4 OF THE BETHEL FUEL SALES AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the current rate for fuel through-put is four (4) cents per gallon; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel uses gallons as the basis for billing for fuel through-put; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel must raise \$2.1 million to complete the funding of the local match for the Bethel Bank Stabilization Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL APPROVES AN INCREASE IN THE FUEL THROUGH-PUT FEE ON BULK FUEL FROM FOUR (4) CENTS PER GALLON TO TEN (10) CENTS PER GALLON ON IN-BOUND FUEL, EFFECTIVE UPON ADOPTION OF THIS RESOLUTION, AND

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THIS FEE SHALL BE REDUCED BACK TO FOUR (4) CENTS PER GALLON, EFFECTIVE ONE YEAR FROM THE DATE OF ADOPTION OF THIS RESOLUTION.
