

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL

SEPT 28, 1964

*Library*

There was no quorum. Present were Swanson, Mendola, Hoffman and Shhirmmer.

The purpose of the meeting was to hear the financial report of Mr Jack Farleigh, of Helda, Sherwood, Noblin and Yerlor.

It was noted that several people had been deliquent on their sales tax at the time of the audit, but all have been paid except Lieb's. The City Clerk was told to make an assessment based on previous sales and add the penalties. The only relief from such penalties will have to be through the City Council.

The Auditor suggested setting up a double entry bookkeeping system that would simplify the City books.

Mr. Farleigh tells us that the State complained that the billing was not being kept up. He suggests that it be done as soon as possible after the end of the month.

The need for street lights at several parts of the City was brought up. They are: by the Jail, at the old school, back of the Cowan hut, by Mendola's and on Hangar road. This is to be brought up at the next regular council meeting.
