ORDINANCE #01-42

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ADOPTED ANNUAL FY 2001-2002 BUDGET

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL THAT THE FY 2001-02 Annual Budget be amended as follows:

Section 1. That the following sums of money as may be needed or deemed necessary to provide for increased expenses and liabilities of the City of Bethel are hereby appropriated for the corporate purposes and objects of the City hereinafter specified for Fiscal Year 2001-02, July 1, 2001 to June 30, 2002.
