#### A RESOLUTION BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING THE PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION AS PART OF THE FY 2003 STATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM II

**WHEREAS**, the State of Alaska, Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Management, has \$1,191,002 available for distribution to protect critical infrastructure as part of the FY 2003 State Homeland Security Grant Program II;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel is one of 30 jurisdictions in the state eligible to receive grant funds from the FY 2003 State Homeland Security Grant Program;

**WHEREAS**, grant applications are due on April 25, 2005;

**WHEREAS**, the funds received from this Homeland Security Grant must be expended by October 31, 2005;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel's Fire Department, Police Department, Public Works Department, and Administration Department plan to contribute ideas for equipment that can be requested in a grant application;


**WHEREAS**, there is no cash match required for this grant;
