RESOLUTION #95-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL REQUESTING THE RELEASE OF MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO THE U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS FOR THE BETHEL BANK STABILIZATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Bethel Bank Stabilization Project was authorized by Congress in section 601 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1986 (Public Law 99-662); and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' number one priority for civil works projects in Alaska is the Bethel Bank Stabilization Project; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the Bethel Bank Stabilization Project including lands, easements and rights-of-way for construction of the project is now estimated at \$19,600,000; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is required to pay 25% of the total project cost, or an estimated \$4,900,000; and

WHEREAS, the City's required cash contribution for Fiscal Year 1995 is estimated to be \$1,500,000 and the Corps of Engineers must receive this amount by the scheduled advertising date of February 1, 1995; and


WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities has committed an initial match amount of \$1,296,000 for this project and the Corps of Engineers has indicated this amount should suffice for the initial phase of the project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has funds available in the amount of \$204,000 to add to the \$1,296,000 from the Department of Transportation to fulfill the required \$1,500,000 for the local match amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council requests the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to release the committed \$1,296,000 for the Bethel Bank Stabilization Project to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers no later than February 1, 1995.
