A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL REQUESTING GRANT FUNDS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES TO PURCHASE VEHICLES NECESSARY TO PROVIDE A MASS TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM FOR THE RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF BETHEL.

WHEREAS, it is desirable and within the City's interest to pursue the development of a mass transit system in the City of Bethel; and,

WHEREAS, the capital investment involved in the purchase of the necessary vehicles is prohibitive to enactment of a full scale mass transit system by private industry; and,


WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities has grant funds available to effect the capital investment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council herein directs the City Administration to execute the necessary documents to obtain grant funds to purchase vehicles for a mass transit system and to contract out the actual operation of the system.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the Council as Council's authorized representative in acceptance and implementation of the grant award.
