ORDINANCE #11-08

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE FACILITIES USE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF BETHEL AND CROWLEY MARINE SERVICES, INC. DATED AUGUST 20, 2002

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel and Crowley Marine Services, Inc. entered into the agreement dated August 20, 2002 for the purpose of allowing Crowley non-exclusive use of the Bethel Petroleum Dock to transfer petroleum products through pipelines to the bulk petroleum tank farm;

WHEREAS, since entering the agreement, Crowley has expanded its operations to include a new bulk petroleum tank farm serviced by a separate set of headers and pipelines servicing the new tank farm which are not presently covered by the current terms of the agreement. ;

WHEREAS, the parties wish to modify the agreement to incorporate the new tank farm headers and pipelines not presently covered by the agreement.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

SECTION 1. Classification. This ordinance is not permanent in nature and shall not be placed in the Bethel Municipal Code.


SECTION 2. Authorization of lease. Based upon the findings stated above, the City is authorized to amend the August 20, 2002 lease agreement between Crowley Marine Services inc. and the City of Bethel and to carry out the terms and conditions of the Amended Facilities Use Agreement.

SECTION 3. Authority of Officers. The City Manager is authorized and directed to do and perform all things and determine all matters not determined by this ordinance, to the end that the City may carry out its obligations under the Facility Use Agreement.

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption of the Bethel City Council.
