

SUPPORTING THE CONTINUED OPERATION OF THE CHRISSIE SHANTZ ADULT DAY PROGRAM OPERATED BY ORUTSARARMIUT NATIVE COUNCIL

- WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel has continued to support the programs provided by the Orutsararmiut Native Council's, Senior Center;
- WHEREAS**, the administration of senior programs, specifically the Chrissie Shantz Adult Day Program provides Bethel's seniors with assistance and supervision when they have a physical, emotional, or cognitive impairment;
- WHEREAS**, the assistance provided includes, but is not limited to: assistance with activities of daily living, health monitoring, assistance with overcoming difficulties associated with functional impairments or disabilities; and or support making transition between living situations;
- WHEREAS**, there is a growing need for senior services in Bethel with no other senior service center in Bethel or the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta the Bethel Senior Center plays a vital role in the quality of life and wellbeing for many elders by providing one-on-one tailored care to the individuals need's and skill level;
- WHEREAS**, the Chrissie Shantz Adult Day Program staff work with partner agencies to ensure wrap around services for elders who attend on a regular basis as well as to those who visit periodically from villages within the YK Delta;
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Bethel City Council hereby supports the continued operation of the Eddie Hoffman Senior Center and Chrissie Shantz Adult Day Program under the direction of ONC.
