**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES IN THEIR EFFORTS TO OBTAIN FUNDING FOR ROAD PROJECTS IN THE CITY OF BETHEL**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel is committed to achieving the best possible road system to serve the residents and visitors of the City and the City of Bethel City Council has established Roads and Transportation Projects as their number two priority for Capital Improvement Projects; and

**WHEREAS**, adequate transportation facilities are essential if the City residents are to enjoy a good standard of living, for expanding commerce, resource development and a suitable environment; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities in compliance with the Federal Highway funding in the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA), seeks to serve the needs of local communities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel seeks to develop and improve its basic infrastructure in an effort to support economic development within the community; and


**WHEREAS**, the local roads are identified and prioritized by the City according to need;


