RESOLUTION #380

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WATER/SEWER VEHICLE MAINTENANCE FACILITY.

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature has appropriated \$428,000.00 to the City of Bethel for the construction of a water/sewer vehicle maintenance facility; and

WHEREAS, the present water/sewer vehicle maintenance facility at Bethel is inadequate to meet the needs of the residents of the City of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska requires a minimum standard as to sanitary requirements with respect to a water system as operated by the City of Bethel; and


WHEREAS, the present water/sewer vehicle maintenance facility at Bethel will not be able to meet the State of Alaska sanitary requirements unless expanded and modernized,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, supports the request for an appropriation of \$428,000.00 from the State of Alaska, Department of Administration, to the City of Bethel for the construction of a water/sewer vehicle maintenance facility.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's representative in accepting and implementing the grant award.
