
WHEREAS, the negotiated agreement between the City of Bethel and the city employees says the City Council may adopt a policy or procedure for drug and/or alcohol testing which shall be applicable to the employees covered by the agreement;

WHEREAS, the City's current drug and/or alcohol testing policy for city employees who must have a commercial driver's license to perform their job duties and responsibilities is in need of revision to conform with applicable federal requirements;

WHEREAS, the City has revised its policy for city employees who must have a commercial driver's license to perform their job duties and responsibilities;


