

ORDINANCE 68

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 42 AND  
RE-ESTABLISHING A COMPREHENSIVE SYSTEM OF  
CODES WHICH SET THE MINIMUM CONDITIONS UNDER  
WHICH BUILDINGS MAY LAWFULLY BE OCCUPIED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA:

SECTION 1.

Ordinance 42 is repealed in its entirety effective  
on passage of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. The following codes shall be adopted by the City  
of Bethel:

Uniform Building Code	Current Edition
National Plumbing Code	Current Edition
National Electrical Code	Current Edition
Uniform Housing Code	Current Edition
Alaska Fire Safety Code	Current Edition

SECTION 3. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any  
provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed  
guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction shall  
be fined in any sum not to exceed the sum of one  
hundred dollars (\$100.00) or ten days in jail or  
both.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effective  
upon passage by the City Council of the City of  
Bethel, Alaska.

SECTION 5. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence clause or phrase of this ordinance should be declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, such decision shall not affect the full force and effect, and for this purpose the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.
