## RESOLUTION #97-25

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, CONCURRING WITH THE ALASKA DOT&PF DESIGN STUDY REPORT FOR PROJECT 52774, "BETHEL STREET IMPROVEMENTS" AND ACCEPTING MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE SECTIONS OF ROAD LISTED THEREIN, UPON COMPLETION OF PROJECT 52774.**

**WHEREAS**, the Alaska DOT&PF has completed a Design Study Report for Project 52774, Bethel Street Improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the Design Study Report proposes to extend the service life of five existing gravel roads by improving their structural sections and providing an all weather recycled asphalt pavement driving surface; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel supports the concept of recycling used asphalt; and


**WHEREAS**, the five existing gravel roads to be improved are:

- Main Street, from the Chief Eddie Hoffman Highway to Front Street,
- Front Street, from Main Street to Oscar Way,
- Oscar Way, from Front Street to Chief Eddie Hoffman Highway,
- First Avenue, from Chief Eddie Hoffman Highway to the End of Maintenance at Kinegak Street, and
- Hangar Lake Road, from just north of Bridge Avenue to the intersection of Osier Avenue and North Harbor Road.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, concurs with the need to improve the five roads listed above, supports the design study which incorporates the use of recycled asphalt, and agrees to maintain the roads after the successful completion of structural improvements and paving of each road.
