BUSINESS:

A motion was made by H. Elliott, seconded by R. Miller, that Mr. Nicholson be directed to prepare a resolution to be presented to the Legislative Council in Bethel on November 7, 1965. Approved unanimously.

General discussions were held concerning the proposed change to the municipal code.

The Council approved ^{that} a protest ~~be~~ ^{for} be made ~~against~~ Bethel and such other cities being forced into first class city situations.

The resolution to be presented to the Legislative Council would include roads, a regional high school, a fisheries biologist to permanently stationed in Bethel, a small boat harbor and a magistrate rather than a deputy magistrate.
