A RESOLUTION REQUESTING ASSISTANCE FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA TO CONDUCT THE PRELIMINARY GROUND WORK AND CONCEPT DESIGN FOR A JOINT LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER

WHEREAS, the facilities for both the Alaska State Troopers and the City of Bethel Police Department are woefully inadequate and in many instances inappropriate in order to obtain the greatest measures of efficiencies and effectiveness;

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of building a facility that would accommodate both the City of Bethel Police Department and the State of Alaska State Troopers office in Bethel;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel encourages the State of Alaska to be a partner in this worthwhile endeavor in order to accomplish the goal of providing adequate and appropriate facilities to accommodate public safety requirements;

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the City to lend support and assist where financially feasible and practical in order to accomplish the goal of providing safe and adequate facilities who are involved in public safety within our community;

WHEREAS, working within partnerships between and among units of local and state governments is a proven way to save costs and maximize limited resources in order to accomplish the overall goals of the community.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Council of the City of Bethel does hereby request the support of the State of Alaska in the amount of \$2,000,000 to provide for the preliminary ground work, geotechnical investigation and concept design for the development of joint Law Enforcement Facility to accommodate the City Police Department and the Alaska State Troopers stationed in Bethel. Council does also hereby agree to provide any technical assistance and support that is within the means of the City to impart.
