A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION, FOR THE PLANNING OF A BETHEL CIVIC CENTER.

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature has appropriated \$100,000.00 to the City of Bethel for the planning of a civic center; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel does not have a public facility available for the scheduling of social, cultural, and civic events; and


WHEREAS, the State of Alaska and the City of Bethel recognize the need to provide for its citizens a place to gather for social and cultural events,


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's representative in accepting and implementing the grant award.
