A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$60,000.00 FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MODEL HEALTH CARE CLINIC AT BETHEL, ALASKA.

WHEREAS, certain segments of Bethel's population are not fully served by the existing medical care structure in Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has appropriated the sum of \$60,000.00 to be used to establish a model health care clinic at Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has determined that a real need for health services for all of the citizens of the City does exist; and


WHEREAS, a non-profit corporation will be established to operate a model health care clinic for the citizens of the City of Bethel,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska, supports the request for an appropriation of \$60,000.00 from the State of Alaska, Department of Administration, to the City of Bethel for the establishment of a model health care clinic for the City of Bethel.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's representative in accepting and implementing the grant award.
