

RESOLUTION 422

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA REQUESTING MATCHING GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES, FOR THE OPERATION OF A RURAL TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is requesting \$85,770 in operating and capital funds from the State Department of Transportation and Public Facilities for a rural bus transportation program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has licensed and encouraged the operation of a bus system since 1980 with the City commencing direct operation of the bus system in August, 1983; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel adopted the recommendations of the Transit Market Study on June 15, 1983, including a five-year plan of bus system improvements benefiting the low income and elderly population of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the Transit Market Study plan was developed with extensive public involvement and coordination with the operators of private non-profit and for-profit providers of transportation in Bethel; and


WHEREAS, the public interest is best served by a level of bus operations which receives financial support from a combination of sources including fares and federal, state, and municipal funds.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska that the City Administration be directed to execute the necessary documents to obtain said grant funds from the State Department of Transportation and Public Facilities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska hereby authorizes the City Administration to act on behalf of the City Council in accepting and implementing the grant award in compliance with all applicable federal and state requirements.
