## REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING - DECEMBER 23, 1968

The meeting was called to order after the appointment by the Council of Art Nicholson to act as mayor in Dave Swanson's absence. Roll was called.

Present: Bruce Crow, Ed Hoffman, Noah Jack, Art Nicholson, Gene Peltola.  
Absent: Al Laroux, Dave Swanson.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved with an addition from Nicholson stating that he voted no on the motion regarding the Sitka Conference because it did not include sending a representative of the Council.

COMMUNICATIONS: Snodgrass read the following letters:

- 1) Request from the Arthur Nicholson Co. for location in the commercial area for a laundromat and dry-cleaning plant.
- 2) Proposal of termination of the Brown Slough contract from Harold Strandburg of the Dept. of Public Works.
- 3) Payment from Dept. of Public Safety for care of State prisoners.
- 4) Letter to Mr. Pollack from Patrick V. Murphy regarding the Safe Streets Act.
- 5) Request for donation for the Youth Activities Program from Agnes Pete, Sec. for the Youth Activities Board of Directors.

M/M Crow, Peltola that the city administrator be instructed to inform Dept. of Public Works that the city council is evaluating the termination proposal and will make a definitive reply by January 10, 1969. Passed.

COMPLAINTS: Crow stated that the snow-machine ordinance is not being enforced and the city policemen should be instructed to do so. He also stated that more street lights are out.

TREASURERS REPORT: Snodgrass presented the state of the budget report as of Nov. 30. M/M Crow, Hoffman that consideration of the budget items be placed on the next regular council meeting agenda. Passed.

ADMINISTRATORS REPORT: Snodgrass reported that a letter regarding the Safe Streets Act has been sent to Mr. Mercer; the survey by the Corps of Engineers has been temporarily discontinued until after the holiday; and the Flood Plane study will be presented at the regular council meeting on Jan. 13, 1969.

MAYORS COMMENTS: None.

REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

M/M Peltola, Jack that the meeting be opened to the public for discussion on the Youth Activities Program. Passed. Sam Oscar reported on what has been done to date on the program. Discussion followed.
