A RESOLUTION OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING THE RESTRUCTURING OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION'S BETHEL FIELD OFFICE

WHEREAS, the Department of Environmental Conservation's Bethel Field Office is responsible for the regulation and oversight of 186 water systems, 13 million gallons of fuel storage, and two rivers; and

WHEREAS, the Bethel Field Office is the largest in the State of Alaska, covering 75,000 square miles and 56 villages; and


WHEREAS, the Bethel Field Office has only one person to respond to the needs of this region; and

WHEREAS, an effort is underway to petition the Department of Environmental Conservation to restructure the Bethel Field Office into a District Office with additional personnel to monitor the health and safety of the residents of this region.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, supports this effort to restructure the Bethel Field Office of the Department of Environmental Conservation into a District Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council calls upon the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Conservation to investigate and address the need for additional personnel to protect the health and well-being of our region.
