WHEREAS, the City of Bethel was a community impacted by the calendar year 2000 fisheries disaster; and


WHEREAS, the City of Bethel Parks & Recreation Department has received a grant from the State of Alaska through the Workforce Investment Act (WIA);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, authorizes Bob Herron, City Manager to negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents and grants required for granting funds to the Workforce Investment Act youth work experience program and managing funds on behalf of this entity.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Bob Herron, City Manager, is also authorized to execute any subsequent amendments to said grant to provide for adjustments to the project within the scope of services or tasks, based upon the needs of the project.
