A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO GRANT THE CITY OF BETHEL THE NECESSARY FUNDS FOR THE PLANNING, DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A SMALL BOAT HARBOR IN BETHEL.

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is a community that is dependent on commercial fisheries, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has requested the Alaska District Engineer to conduct a special report and assist in the design of a boat harbor that would meet the needs of Bethel, and

WHEREAS, the sight for the boat harbor has been selected, and


WHEREAS, the Alaska Legislature has approved \$1,514,900.00 for this project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethel that the City Administration be directed to execute the necessary documents to obtain grant funds from the Department of Administration for the planning, design and construction for a small boat harbor for Bethel.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's authorized representative in acceptance and implementation of the grant award.
