municipal assistance funding; and


WHEREAS, this resolution must be submitted to the Department

by law.

AN AMENDMENT OF A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING MUNICIPAL AID FUNDS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE FOR SPECIFIC CAPITAL PROJECTS AND SOCIAL SERVICE PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, the Alaska Legislature under the provisions of Ch. 60, SLA 81 and SLA 82 and AS 37.05.315 has appropriated \$920,823.92 to the City of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, The City of Bethel has the authority to disburse these funds on Capital Projects and Social Service Programs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the Bethel, Alaska, that the original FY '83 Entitlement Agreement for Municipal Aid be amended so that the following changes are made to the grant allocation statement:


PROJECT #2: Child Sexual Abuse Program
Increase budget by \$15,000.00
New Budget Amount: \$52,000.00

PROJECT #4: Boardwalk Construction and Park
Development Decrease Budget by
\$15,000.00, New Budget Amount:
\$185,000.00.

FURTHER, that the City Manager of Bethel, Alaska, is hereby authorized to secure and implement the grant amendment and to carry out the terms as specified.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council agrees that the \$920,823.92 allocation will be expended per attachments I and II.
