A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA AUTHORIZING THE KUSKOKWIM CONSORTIUM LIBRARY COMMITTEE TO WORK WITH THE CITY OF BETHEL IN PLANNING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW LIBRARY FACILITY FOR BETHEL.

WHEREAS, the Kuskokwim Consortium Library is serving an increasing number of student and citizen patrons each year in its primary service area; and


WHEREAS, the Kuskokwim Consortium Library is taking on the role of a regional resource center for the Lower Kuskokwim and Yukon Delta; and

WHEREAS, the present facilities of the Kuskokwim Consortium Library are rapidly becoming inadequate to meet the needs of its constituents,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, in the interest of planning for the construction of the library facility, that the Bethel City Council authorize the Library Advisory Committee of the Kuskokwim Consortium Library to work with the City of Bethel to do preliminary program needs assessment, a funding source assessment, and to work with the City's Capital Projects Director and City Planner and with other relevant groups to produce a construction plan for the library.
