

RESOLUTION #404

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, GRANTING CONCEPTUAL APPROVAL TO THE BETHEL COASTAL MANAGEMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature in 1977 adopted the Alaska Coastal Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Coastal Management Program is designed to be a joint effort by local, state, and federal governments and the private sector to manage coastal resources and to promote their wise and balanced use; and

WHEREAS, Section 46.40.210(2) of the Alaska Statutes provides that second class cities that exercise planning authorities and have a planning commission are able to participate in the Alaska Coastal Management Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel, a second class city, through Ordinance No. 55 established a planning commission for the City of Bethel which exercises planning authorities; and

WHEREAS, the Bethel City Council, in 1980, chose to participate in the Alaska Coastal Management Program pursuant to A.S. 46.40.210; and

WHEREAS, the Preliminary Report of the Bethel Coastal Management Plan was distributed in February, 1982; and

WHEREAS, a public meeting and a public hearing on the Preliminary Report were subsequently held; and

WHEREAS, the Public Hearing Draft of the Bethel Coastal Management Plan was distributed in March, 1983; and

WHEREAS, two public hearings and seven public meetings on the Public Hearing Draft of the Bethel Coastal Management Plan were subsequently held; and


WHEREAS, comments from the public, state, and federal agencies, and the private sector were received and considered in revising the Public Hearing Draft of the Bethel Coastal Management Plan; and


WHEREAS, this Draft is currently before the City Council of Bethel, Alaska,
