WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is concerned with public safety and the City's Parks and Recreation Department is responsible for maximizing safety within parks under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, many traditional snow trails leading from outlying villages to Bethel funnel through Pinky's Park; and

WHEREAS, when originally created, the Pinky's Park Boardwalk Project, sponsored by the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, did not fully address the safety issue of boardwalk crossings; and

WHEREAS, the 2004 Recreation Trails Grant from the Alaska Department of Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation, will help to solve many of the safety concerns related to the safe operation of snow machines and dog teams over the boardwalk; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel will be responsible for the operation and maintenance of the boardwalk crossings throughout the useful life of the project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel was awarded \$14,230 as part of the 2004 Recreation Trails Grant, with an in-kind match required by the City of Bethel of \$3,558;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Bethel City Council accepts the 2004 Recreation Trails Grant, in the amount of \$14,230, awarded to the City of Bethel from the Alaska Department of Natural Resources, Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation
