### A RESOLUTION OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING THE TUNDRA WOMEN'S COALITION'S APPLICATION FOR AN EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANT

**WHEREAS**, the Tundra Women's Coalition is a non-profit organization that provides emergency shelter for victims of sexual, physical and emotional abuse, both children and adults; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tundra Women's Coalition offers shelter for as many as thirty victims at one time; and

**WHEREAS**, the structure housing the Tundra Women's Coalition was built in 1983; and


**WHEREAS**, the years of use have taken a toll on the water, sewer and heating systems of the building; and

**WHEREAS**, the State of Alaska has Emergency Shelter Grant funds available to aid in repairing these essential support systems; and

**WHEREAS**, the Tundra Women's Coalition is applying for these funds and agrees to abide by the conditions governing the grant.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Bethel City Council supports the application of the Tundra Women's Coalition for the State of Alaska Emergency Shelter Grant Program for the replacement of the baseboard heating system, the upgrade of the water treatment system and additional necessary renovations to ensure the safety and security of the shelter's clients.
