A RESOLUTION REQUESTING CAPITAL FUNDING THROUGH THE STATE OF ALASKA VILLAGE SAFE WATER PROGRAM—STAGE 2 IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CITY SUBDIVISION WATER AND SEWER PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City Council, herein after called the Council, is governing the body of the City of Bethel, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to provide adequate sanitation facilities for the residents of Bethel, Alaska and has determined the water and sewer project to be a number one priority for the community; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Environment Conservation/Village Safe Water Program, hereinafter called VSW, can provide the technical assistance necessary to improve the sanitation program; and

NOW, THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council hereby requests the Governor and Legislature appropriate \$3,300,000 through the VSW Program to design and build the Stage 2 City Subdivision Water and Sewer Improvement Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council hereby authorizes VSW or its representatives to enter upon or cross community land for the purposes of assisting the Council in carrying out this water and sewer improvement project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council will cooperate with the provisions of needed agreements entered into between the Council and VSW, and that said provisions will be duly carried out.
