## SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING JULY 24, 1968

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Arthur Nicholson

Present: Art Dull, J.B. Haroldsen, Ed Hoffman, Al Laroux, Arthur Nicholson  
Absent: David Swanson, Bruce Crow

REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEES: M/M Nicholson, Laroux to clean up the dump and dump gravel where necessary. Al Laroux offered some fencing to the City.

### SEA WALL:

Ed Hoffman, Al Laroux, J.B. Haroldsen were appointed members of the Work Project Committee. Resolution 49 was put into its first reading by Mayor Nicholson. M/M Laroux, Haroldsen that Resolution 49 be accepted in its first reading and be put into its second reading by title only. Passed unanimously

M/M Laroux, Haroldsen that Resolution 49 be accepted in its second and final reading  
Poll Vote 5-0 in favor

### SEVENTH AVENUE:

M/M Hoffman, Dull that seventh avenue road be put out for bid. Passed unanimously.

### CITY POLICE:

Mayor Nicholson reported that the State would not furnish Bethel with a Trooper for at least a year but would assist us in any other way in securing a City Policeman. Discussion was held on the application for the City Policeman. M/M Hoffman, Haroldsen that we offer the position to Daniel Mayer at the beginning salary of \$11,000 per year to be raised to \$11,500 after six months and \$12,000 after a year.

M/M Hoffman, Laroux that Mayor Nicholson call the Governor and ask if the Trooper will cover Bethel and if not the City will hire one locally until a full time Policeman is available. Passed

### Jail Contract;

The Jail Contract was postponed until next meeting.

PRISONER FEEDING: M/M Nicholson, Hoffman that letter be written to Helen Lewis advising her that the Prisoner Feeding contract is expired and ask her to continue until the contract be put out for bid. New bid may be cancelled by either party upon 30 day written notice. Passed.

PIT LAKE: Discussion was held on an alternate lake for the Campfire Girls swimming school. H Marker Lake and Gravel Lake were chosen. Arthur Nicholson said he would take water samples of the two lakes and send them into the state for contamination tests.

M/M Hoffman, Dull that we purchase a complete new head for dump truck. Passed 5-0
