SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING - JULY 25, 1969

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dave Swanson. Roll was called.

Absent: Gene Peltola.

OLD BUSINESS:

ORDINANCE 43:

M/M Crow, Nicholson to table consideration of Ordinance 43. Passed unanimously.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT:

M/M Crow, Nicholson to table Memorandum of Agreement. Passed unanimously.

APPROVAL OF BUDGET:

M/M Crow, Hoffman to table consideration of the budget until the next regular meeting. Passed unanimously.

TRANSFER OF LAND TO STATE:

M/M Nicholson, Crow that Transfer of Land to State be tabled. Passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

ORDINANCE 44:

M/M Crow, Nicholson that consideration of Ordinance 44 be tabled until the next meeting and that the City Administrator be instructed to inform people who will apparently be in violation of it that it will be discussed at this date.
Passed unanimously.

PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT:

M/M Crow, Jack that this be tabled. Passed unanimously.

BROWN SLOUGH CULVERT:

No action taken.

SIREN TIMER:

M/M Jack, Hoffman that the siren blow at 8A.M. and 10 P.M. daily.

Amended by Crow, Hoffman that it be blown at noon also. Poll vote on amendment:
Crow yes, Hoffman yes, Jack yes, Laroux yes, Nicholson no, Swanson no. Amendment carried 4-2.

Poll vote on main motion: Crow yes, Hoffman yes, Jack yes, Laroux no, Nicholson no, Swanson no. Motion not carried (3-3).

M/M Crow, Jack that the siren be timed to blow at curfew time as designated by ordinance. Passed unanimously.

B.A.R.C. GAMING PERMIT:

M/M Nicholson, Laroux that the City Council approve the B.A.R.C. application for a gaming permit. Passed unanimously.

M/M Nicholson, Crow that the meeting be adjourned. Second withdrawn. Motion dead.

M/M Crow, Hoffman that the MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT be considered at tonite's meeting. Passed unanimously.

M/M Crow, Jack that the City Council accept the Memorandum of Agreement and that the City Administrator be instructed to inform Alaska Native Health Service of this action. Passed unanimously.

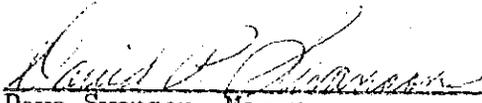

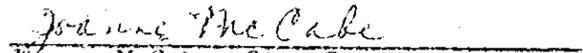
M/M Crow, Jack that consideration of TRANSFER OF LAND be considered at this meeting. Passed unanimously.

M/M Crow, Hoffman that a limited deed as described in the letter dated June 24, 1969 by Burton Biss, City Attorney, to the City be accepted by the City Council and the City Administrator be instructed to sign it with the condition that the City recognizes that a clouded title exists to certain portions of it due to a "Native allotment". Passed unanimously.
