

ORDINANCE NO. 122

An act providing for an increase in the rate of sales tax levied on sales within the City:

BE IT ORDINANCED by the City Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska

- (1) That Section 3.04.020A of the Bethel Code of Ordinances is amended to read:

A consumer's sales tax is levied on all sales, rents and services made in the City at the rate of five percent (5%) of the selling price. Normally, the burden of this tax rests upon the consumer.

- (2) That Section 3.04.070 is amended to read:

The seller shall add to the selling price an amount following scale:

<u>Selling Price</u>	<u>Amount of Sales Tax</u>
.11 - .30 .....	\$.01
.31 - .50 .....	\$.02
.51 - .70 .....	\$.03
.71 - .90 .....	\$.04
.91 - 1.10 .....	\$.05
over 1.10 .....	5% of Sales Price

- (3) The increased rate of tax provided for by this Ordinance shall become effective only upon a proposition in the following form receiving a majority of the votes cast at the next special election.

Shall the rate of sales tax imposed pursuant to A.S. 29.53.415 and Bethel Code of Ordinances 3.04 be increased from three percent (3%) to five percent (5%)?
