

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 86-1

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, AMENDING TITLE 4 OF THE BETHEL CODE OF ORDINANCES SETTING JUNE 30, 1986 AS THE FINAL DATE FOR ADOPTION OF THE 1987 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET.

WHEREAS, AS 29.25.030 provides for emergency ordinances; and

WHEREAS, budget procedures adopted in 1985 require the City Manager to prepare an annual budget estimate not later than May 1 for the following fiscal year and that the City Council adopt a budget and make the appropriations by ordinance not later than the 15th day of June; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel employed a new City Manager early in 1986 and the Alaska State Legislature's determinations on revenue sharing funds for Bethel were not resolved until late in the legislative session ending in May, 1986, and the City Manager and City Council have been engaged in a variety of responsibilities requiring prompt and immediate attention; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing conditions have prevented, despite the despite the best efforts of the City Manager and City Council, the preparation of a meaningful budget estimate and have presented substantial obstacles to the ability of the City Council to make and appropriation; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing statements of fact and conditions constitute the existence of an emergency.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska that:

SECTION ONE: Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 4.02.020, the City Manager shall prepare and submit to the City Council, not later than June 15, 1986, an annual budget estimate for fiscal year 1987 and a budget message.

SECTION TWO: Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 4.02.050, the City Council shall adopt the budget and make the necessary appropriation by ordinance for fiscal year 1987 not later than June 30, 1986.
