A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO GRANT THE CITY OF BETHEL THE NECESSARY FUNDS TO CONDUCT A FISH PROCESSING INDUSTRY FEASIBILITY STUDY.

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature approved a Municipal Grant to the City of Bethel in the amount of \$15,000.00 to conduct a fish processing feasibility study for a plant in Bethel, and

WHEREAS, Many people in Bethel and the region are dependent of the fisheries as it is their primary source of income, and


WHEREAS, the majority of processing of the fish caught is done outside the region which may be provided locally.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethel that the City Administration be directed to execute the necessary documents to obtain grant funds from the Department of Administration for the City of Bethel to conduct a fish processing industry feasibility study.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's authorized representative in acceptance and implementation of the grant award.
