

RESOLUTION 483

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA SUPPORTING CONTINUED FUNDING FOR THE PHILLIPS ALCOHOL TREATMENT CENTER.

WHEREAS, alcohol abuse has been identified as a major problem in Bethel and the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Bethel, Alaska strongly supports alcohol treatment for Bethel and the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta; and

WHEREAS, the Phillips Alcohol Treatment Center has been recognized and funded by SOADA to provide alcohol treatment services for Bethel and the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta; and

WHEREAS, continued funding of the Phillips Alcohol Treatment Center program is necessary for the treatment of those who are afflicted by alcohol abuse; and

WHEREAS, the Phillips Alcohol Treatment Center has in recent months experienced problems with staff turnover and other issues; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Bethel, Alaska has appointed an advisory board for the Phillips Alcohol Treatment Center to address staffing problems and other issues confronting the Phillips Alcohol Treatment Center including the possible transfer of the Phillips Alcohol Treatment Center by the City of Bethel to another agency.

WHEREAS, there is a feasibility study underway concerning the operation of the Phillips Alcohol Treatment Center, that study to include a review of the feasibility of the City of Bethel transferring the operation of the Phillips Alcohol Treatment Center to another agency.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA THAT FUNDING FOR PATC BE GRANTED AS REQUESTED.
