

SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING  
AUGUST 31, 1972

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Guinn at 8:15 pm, KVHA Building, Bethel.

ROLL CALL

Present: Guinn, Hoffman, Murphy, Romer, Zahradnicek.  
Absent : Cooke, Dale.

Mayor Guinn opened the meeting by explaining the purpose of the meeting. He stated the City needed extra revenue and by increasing the sales tax, that 1 % increase would bring in approximately \$70,000 a year. The way to place this increase on the October 3 rd ballot was by a resolution. He entertained a motion to place Resolution 78 in its first reading.

A) Placing the increase of Sales Tax on the ballot.

M/M Romer, Murphy , so move to place Resolution 78 in its first reading.

Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

Mr. Benson then read Resolution #78 in its entirety.

M/M Murphy, Zahradnicek, so move we accept Resolution #78 in its first reading.

Motion passed by unanimous Roll Call Vote.

M/M Murphy, Hoffman so move we place Resolution #78 in its second reading by title only.

Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.

Mr. Benson read Resolution #78 by title only.

M/M Murphy, Hoffman so move we accept Resolution #78 in its second and final reading.

Motion passed by unanimous Roll Call Vote.

B) Numbering the Seats-up for Council.

Mayor Guinn explained that with the new Municipal code coming in effect, September 10, 1972, it states a person running for council will have to receive 40% of the votes to be impossible if we did it like in the past. We would have to number each seat up and have the people filing, choose which seat he or she would like to run for.

M/M Zahradnicek, Hoffman so move to number the seats in alphabetical order by last name, subject to the numbers be numerical from the alphabet.

Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.


M/M Hoffman, Romer so move we adjourn

Meeting adjourned at 8:35 pm.


