

ORDINANCE NO. 23

An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 1
by repealing and re-enacting Sections 9,
10 and 11 and providing an effective date

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA:

Section 1. Repealer. Sections 9, 10 and 11 of Ordinance No. 1
are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Re-enacting. Sections 9, 10 and 11 of Ordinance No. 1
are hereby re-enacted into law as follows:

Sec. 9. The tax provided by this Ordinance shall be
~~for a period of six months beginning on June 1, 1964~~
June 1, 1964 in effect indefinitely unless repealed or amended

Sec. 10. This Ordinance shall be in full force and
effect on and after June 1, 1964.

Sec. 11. Any person, firm, co-partnership or corpor-
ation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance
shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction
thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed One
Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars or imprisoned in the city jail
not to exceed ten (10) days. Each separate offense shall
be deemed a separate violation and may be punished as such.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on
June 1, 1964.
