

ORDINANCE No. 85

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES FOR GARBAGE SERVICE AND MODIFYING RATES FOR WATER AND SEWER SERVICE.

THE CITY OF BETHEL ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

For the collection, removal and disposal of Residential/Commercial garbage, rubbish and waste material within the City, the following charges shall be made:

- (1) Residential service (1 time per week) - \$ 8.00 per month.
- (2) Residential service (2 times per week) - 12.00 per month.
- (3) Residential service (3 times per week) - 16.00 per month.
- (4) Commercial service (1 time per week) - 30.00 per month.
- (5) Commercial service (2 times per week) - 60.00 per month.
- (6) Commercial service (3 times per week) - 90.00 per month.
- (7) Commercial service (4 times per week) - 120.00 per month.
- (8) Commercial service (5 times per week) - 150.00 per month.
- (9) Commercial service (6 times per week) - 180.00 per month.
- (10) Commercial service (7 times per week) - 210.00 per month.

SECTION 2.

For the providing of water within the City, the following charges shall be made:

For providing on-call scheduled collection, removal and disposal of residential/commercial garbage, rubbish and waste material; residential/commercial water delivery service; and residential/commercial sewage service within the City, the following charges shall be made:

(1) Garbage Service.

(a)	Residential Service	\$2.50 per scheduled call
(b)	Commercial Service	7.50 per scheduled call

(2) Water Delivery Service.

- (a) Inside Fill \$0.045 per gallon per scheduled call
- (b) Outside Fill 0.035 per gallon per scheduled call

(3) Sewage Service.

- (a) Haul Service \$ 1.50 per scheduled call
- (b) Evacuation Service 22.50 per scheduled call

SECTION 6.

(1) The monthly Residential/Commercial rates charged for the collection of garbage, rubbish and waste material; delivery of water; and removal of sewage within the City, shall not include providing such services on or during officially recognized City holidays as described in the City's Personnel Policies, Rules and Regulations.

(2) The monthly Residential/Commercial rates charged for the collection of garbage, rubbish and waste material; delivery of water; and removal of sewage within the City, are also established on the basis of three (3) days per annum for garbage service, three (3) days per annum for water service, and three (3) days per annum for sewer service which may not be implemented because of mechanical malfunctions experienced by City-owned vehicles engaged in providing the utility services described herein.

(3) Customers who do not receive Residential/Commercial garbage, water or sewer services four (4) or more times a year in each of the aforementioned utility service areas, excluding officially recognized City holidays; physical or other impediments created by the customer to all Residential/Commercial garbage, water or sewer areas (e.g., locked doors, the presence of animals); and the three (3) days per annum per utility service area which may not be implemented because of mechanical malfunctions experienced by City-owned vehicles engaged in providing the utility services described herein, may request and shall be granted by the City, an adjustment to their utility bills as supported by utility records maintained by the City's Public Works Department and Finance Department. Such requests by a utility customer shall be made to the City's Finance Department within thirty (30) days after utility bills are mailed by the City. If a utility customer makes a request for an adjustment to the utility bill after the aforementioned thirty (30) day time period, such request will be considered invalid by the City.

SECTION 7.

The City Manager shall have the power and authority to enter into contractual arrangements with any person for the provision of any of the above services at rates or terms different from those set out above, subject to the approval of City Council.

SECTION 8.

All or any portion of any code, provision or ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

SECTION 9.



THE CITY OF BETHEL ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

For the collection, removal and disposal of Residential/Commercial garbage, rubbish and waste material within the City, the following charges shall be made:

(1) Residential/Commercial Scheduled Rates:

- (a) Residential Service 2 times per month - \$ 5.50 per month.
- (b) Residential Services 1 time per week - 8.75 per month.
- (c) Residential Service 2 time per week - 13.05 per month.
- (d) Residentail Service 3 times per week - 17.05 per month.
- (e) Commercial Service 1 time per week - 32.70 per month.
- (f) Commercial Service 2 times per week - 65.40 per month.
- (g) Commercial Service 3 times per week - 98.10 per month.
- (h) Commercial Service 4 times per week - 130.80 per month.
- (i) Commercial Service 5 times per week - 163.50 per month.

(2) Residential/Commercial On-Call Rates:

- (a) Residentail Services - \$10.90 per call.
- (b) Commercial Services - \$32.70 per call.

If a utility customer makes a request for an adjustment to the utility bill after the aforementioned thirty (30) day time period, such request will be considered invalid by the City.

(4) The city of Bethel shall not be held liable for water damage to any property, where the customer has failed to install an adequate operative overflow system, or has failed to keep the overflow line from freezing.

SECTION 5.

The City Manager shall have the power and authority to enter into contractual arrangements with any person for the provision of any of the above services at rates or terms different from those set out above, subject to the approval of City Council.

SECTION 6.

All or any portion of any code, provision or Ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

SECTION 7.

If any portion of this Chapter is held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remainder of this Chapter, and, to that end, this Chapter is declared to be severable.

SECTION 8.

The effective date for Modification #1 of Ordinance #85, (AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING THE RATES FOR WATER, SEWER AND GARBAGE SERVICES.) shall be July 1, 1979.

MODIFICATION NO. 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 85

A MODIFICATION OF ORDINANCE 85 ESTABLISHING A CREDIT FOR SENIOR CITIZENS THAT UTILIZE THE CITY OF BETHEL UTILITY SERVICES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL:

That Section 11.16.080 be added to the City Utilities Ordinance.

11.16.080 SENIOR CITIZENS UTILITY CREDIT

Any Bethel citizen at least 60 years of age residing in their own household shall receive up to a \$25.00 monthly utility credit if they are the primary source of income after making application for such at the City of Bethel Utilities Office.

All other Bethel citizens at least 60 years of age that do not meet the above conditions shall receive up to a \$10.00 monthly utility credit after making application for such to the City of Bethel Utilities Office.

Each Residential unit shall be limited to one credit application.

Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective February 1, 1980.





Section 1. For the collection, removal and disposal of Residential/Commerical garbage, rubbish and waste material within the City, the following charges shall be made:


- (1) Residential Service using city provided containers that are placed around the City at \$7.25/month.

 - (c) 8 yd container 1 x a wk service \$ 82.81/month
 - (d) 8 yd container 2 x a wk service \$165.52/month
- (3) Residential/Commercial scheduled rates for road pick-up on site:
 - (a) Residential 2 x a wk service \$15.00/month
 - (b) Commercial 2 x a wk service \$35.00/month





B. Each bill entered shall be due upon receipt. If the bill is not paid by the fifteenth day of the month in which mailed, the account shall be considered delinquent.

13.08.220 Delinquency.

A. The Finance Department shall send a notice of account delinquency to each customer when the account becomes delinquent.


