A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE BETHEL TOURISM PROMOTION PROJECT, WHICH INCLUDES AN APPLICATION FOR A VISTA VOLUNTEER TO PERFORM DUTIES THAT PROMOTE TOURISM IN AND AROUND BETHEL, ALASKA

WHEREAS, businesses that would benefit by increased tourism to Bethel make up a substantial part of the Bethel economy;

WHEREAS, there exists untapped potential for future tourism-related businesses in Bethel;

WHEREAS, a tourism planner with the Alaska Department of Community and Economic Development is willing to help promote tourism to Bethel;

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Community and Economic Development accepts and approves applications for VISTA Volunteers on behalf of the Corporation for National Service from organizations intent on fostering economic development;


WHEREAS, approval of a City-sponsored VISTA Volunteer application means that the City will provide to the VISTA Volunteer: supervision, housing assistance, office space, office equipment and supplies, and other resources necessary to achieve project goals;


WHEREAS, the application for a VISTA Volunteer must provide a plan for sustainability, such as the coordination of a multi-agency funding source to fund the services performed by the Volunteer after his or her year of service ends;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council supports the Bethel Tourism Promotion Project and directs the Grant Development Manager to complete and submit an application to the Alaska Department of Community and Economic Development for a VISTA Volunteer.
