PROCLAIMING MAY 17-23, 1999 AS
NOBODY GETS HURT WEEK

Whereas, Alaskans spend eighty million dollars (\$80,000,000) each year paying for unintentional deaths and injuries; and

Whereas, every year Alaska has the highest death rate from unintentional injuries of any of the fifty states; and

Whereas, Alaska has a job-related death rate five times the United States national average, and a fire death rate six times the United States national average; and

Whereas, the Denali Safety Council has proposed the "Nobody Gets Hurt" theme based on its own proven program for reducing injuries in the workplace and in the community; and

Whereas, the City of Bethel commends these efforts and wishes to demonstrate a commitment to improving safety and health of our employees and our citizens by proclaiming an annual "Nobody Gets Hurt Week";


Now, therefore. I, Agnes L. Phillips, Mayor of the City of Bethel, Alaska, do hereby proclaim May 17 - 23, 1999, as

in Bethel, Alaska.


