A RESOLUTION BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING THE FY05 MINI-GRANT APPLICATION SUBMITTED TO THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FOR A MULTIUSE RECREATION FACILITY PLAN

WHEREAS, the need for a multiuse recreation facility has been documented by the community of Bethel as far back as the mid 1970s;

WHEREAS, a first step in the process leading to construction of a multiuse recreation facility is to develop a plan encompassing broad community input;


WHEREAS, the plan would satisfy the need for research into the feasibility of a multiuse recreation facility identified in the Bethel Community Economic Development Strategy Plan's Two-Year Action Plan (May 2003);

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Community and Economic Development's FY05 Mini-Grant for \$30,000 can be used for plan development as long as the project "will improve the community economy in a significant and long lasting way;"

WHEREAS, three consulting companies provided documentation to support the cost of developing a multiuse recreation facility for approximately \$30,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Bethel City Council supports the FY05 Mini-Grant application submitted on July 8, 2004 for a multiuse recreation facility plan to the State of Alaska, Department of Community and Economic Development, Division of Community Advocacy, in partnership with the Denali Commission and United States Department of Agriculture, Forest Service.
