

RESOLUTION 464

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA REQUESTING EMERGENCY SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA TO EXTEND THE MULTI-PURPOSE BULKHEAD ALONG MISSION ROAD AND AT THE BETHEL PETROLEUM DOCK.

WHEREAS, a severe breakup, high flood waters and continuing high water levels at Bethel have accelerated the rate of erosion along the Kuskokwim River at Bethel and have caused severe riverbank failures; and

WHEREAS, the severe erosion and riverbank failures at Bethel are occurring in areas unprotected by the multi-purpose bulkhead thereby threatening life, property and community well-being; and

WHEREAS, the extension of the multi-purpose bulkhead would prevent further severe erosion along the riverbank at Mission Road and at the Petroleum Dock; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel wants to prevent further riverbank failure and the consequent danger to life, property and community well-being.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska that the Bethel City Administration, on behalf of the City of Bethel, be directed to request emergency supplemental funds from the State of Alaska in the amount of \$7,472,000 for the emergency extension of the multi-purpose bulkhead at Bethel along Mission Road and at the Petroleum Dock.
